



- 10,000+ folders, organized by immigrant' name





- Danish Sisterhood in progress...








- Creating books/binders of documents


Special Collections

Special Collections

- Mainly stored in stacks in a climate-controlled room of the museum
- Contents documented in Past Perfect
- Finding aids created with box inventories
- Organized into family collections, by organization, publication, or topic

Basic Description: The Danish Society Dania of California – Nevada was founded in 1879 in Oakland, California, to assist Danish immigrant members in adjusting to life in the U.S.— providing sick and funeral benefits to members as well as helping them find employment—while preserving and celebrating the Danish language and Danish customs. Twenty-eight Dania lodges were formed throughout California and Nevada, governed by a Grand Lodge comprised of delegates from each branch and elected Grand Officers. The wives of Dania men eventually established their own lodges and Grand Lodge Dannebrog, growing to 23 branches, 12 of which were active as of 2008.

Preservation

- Acid-free, lignin-free folders & boxes in appropriate sizes
- Folders labeled in pencil, not ink
- Extraneous materials like paper clips, rubber bands, etc. removed
- Polyester and polypropylene sleeves for documents and photos
 - Avoid encapsulation, which accelerates deterioration

 - Buffered vs. unbuffered storage materials

What you can do now for your own family collection

- Digitize scan both sides of photos and documents, label/title clearly
 - Make photocopies
 - Transcribe
- Store materials safely acid-free sleeves, folders, boxes
 - Do NOT laminate...this causes documents to deteriorate faster
- Identify photographs—people, places, point in time
- Organize by person/family
