Why Use the University Library?

- To find/use materials that are <u>not</u> online nor available in other local libraries.
- For on-site access to databases that ISU subscribes to (walk-in users can get free guest login at Main Desk).
- To flesh out the bones of family histories e.g., soldier letters, social events, news, biographies, major weather events, etc.

Collection Examples:

- Personal Name Index to the 1856 City Directories of Iowa
- Soldier registers e.g., North Carolina Cavalry in the Civil War: a history and roster
- Daily Life of U.S. Soldiers [3 vol. set]
- Books about historic gravestone art & symbolism
- Tornado: Accounts of Tornadoes in Iowa
- The Birth Certificate: an American history
- Keeping Family Secrets: Shame and Silence in Memoirs...
- Use <u>QuickSearch</u> on library website to look for these & more.

Collection Oddities:

In addition to U.S. records, the ISU library collection includes information on immigrant groups & vital records from:

Australia Ireland

Barbados Italy

England Manitoba

Germany Mexico

Greece Norway

Tips for Parks Library visits:

- Check <u>Library hours</u> & SCUA hours in advance.
- To use databases on-site (get guest login – at Main Desk)
- Bring flash drive(s)
- Use FREE scanners
- Avoid beginning of each semester – scanners busy
- Wireless access available for campus guests

- Use QuickSearch and/or <u>CARDinal</u> from home – bring call numbers & locations list with you.
- Parking: Memorial Union parking garage (not free) or

 parking around bus station north of football stadium (FREE bus to campus from there – alert driver if you've not been to library before and they will make sure you get there)
